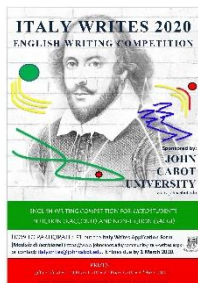


28 Feb. Deadline to register for [Italy Starts](#). (40 hours PCTO)
